Newhouse is a place where survivors can heal and they are empowered to achieve their full potential.

We are also Kansas City's **only domestic violence shelter** that provides...



a **full-time Early Learning Center** for children birth through age five and an **on-site Educational Innovation Center** serving kids in grades K-12 with a customized educational plan.



care with no time limit. This allows a person to truly heal from complex traumas, become self-sufficient, and reduces their risk of returning to their abuser or becoming homeless.



a **dedicated court advocate and an Attorney**, who is barred in both Kansas and Missouri, to help survivors navigate the legal system including orders of protection, divorce, and child custody.

Also, Newhouse is the **only domestic violence shelter in the KC urban core.** Eighty-five percent of violent crimes prosecuted in Jackson County happen within a 3-mile radius of our shelter.



The ecosystem of services we are building

Newhouse has established a new community-centric vision to:

- **change** the landscape from the ground up
- **evolve** how we approach social work
- **reduce** recidivism (return to shelter or unhealthy situations)
- **create** efficiencies in the social services system



PROGRAM + SERVICE HIGHLIGHTS

Focusing on the Next Generation

We meet people where they are. Using experiential learning and innovative therapeutic modalities, our focus is to reduce the developmental impacts of trauma for children through our full-time Early Learning Center and Educational Innovation Center.

Safe Housing

We are an 88-bed emergency shelter providing no-cost, safe housing for adults and children who have escaped violent/abusive homes.

Legal Advocacy

Our attorney and court advocates are at the sides of survivors as they navigate the complex legal system for orders of protection, divorce, and custody cases.

Children + Adult Therapy

Therapists help survivors feel empowered and able to address depression, PTSD, family issues, and the trauma they have experienced.

Case Management

Case managers partner with clients to set goals and access community resources to achieve housing, employment, and self-sufficiency.
