Construction of the President began in 1924 and opened in 1926 as one of downtown Kansas City's original grand hotel. A \$45.4 million dollar restoration project was performed to the specifications of the National Historic Preservation Society in many areas of the hotel and re-opened fully restored and modernized in 2006.

The hotel is situated in the heart of the booming downtown renaissance known as the Power and Light Entertainment District which is home to many dining and entertainment options.

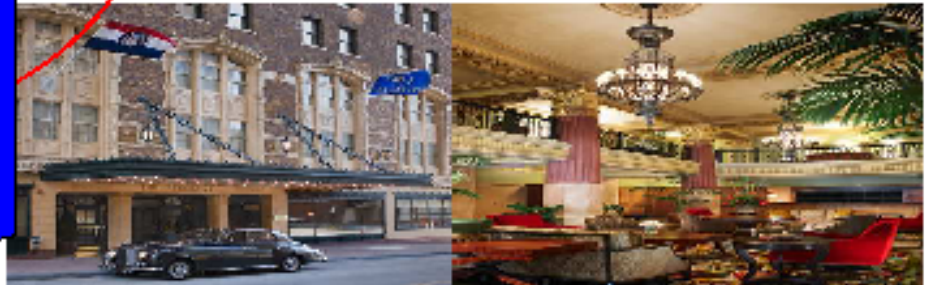

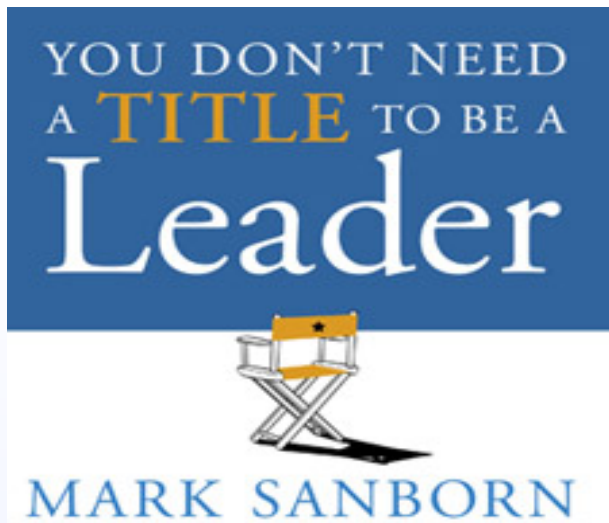

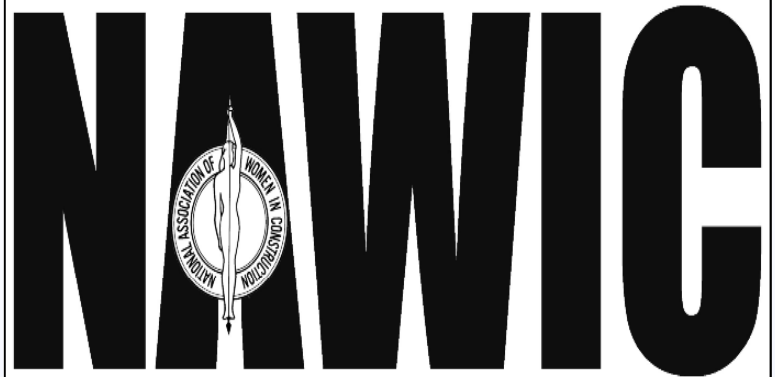
